Venue

The base for #CHWA 2020 is <u>The Wardwick, Derby Museums</u>; formerly the old central library building in Derby.

The central space is light, comfortable yet full of historical character and charm. With panoramas of the bustling streets of Derby and connection to the galleries and museums on site, this venues sets a perfect backdrop for a couple days of being curious about culture and care.

Breakout sessions and workshops are being planned for venues across the city, including QUAD and Air Arts at the Royal Derby Hospital. For venues beyond a short walking distance, transport and guides will be provided.

Travel

Address: The Museum & Art Gallery, The Wardwick, Derby

On arrival: The entrance to the venue is on The Wardwick, the former central library building, on the right hand side of the one way street <u>street view</u>

The venue is central to Derby City Centre and serviced by local bus routes. It is approximately a 10 minute walk away from the Bus Station and 20 minute walk/ 1 mile from Derby Midland Railway Station. There is a taxi rank at the entrance of the train station.

Parking

There is no onsite parking, however there are a number of parking options within walking distance of the venue. Options are:

- Bold Lane Car Park DE1 3NT multi-storey (1 minute walk to venue) <u>http://parksafesystems.com/derby.html</u>. There are 350 daytime spaces and 11 clearly marked Blue Badge parking spaces available free of charge. 24 hours parking.
- Chapel St, Derby DE1 3GU multi-storey (3 minute walk to venue)
- Becketwell Lane Car Park located DE1 1AA open air (2 minute walk to venue)

Hotels and Accommodation

There are many hotels in close proximity to the venue and railway station.
